

## Domestic Violence Perpetrator Pathways in the Czech Republic: The Current Practice and Future Challenges

The main aim of this poster is to present the possible ways in which a perpetrator of domestic violence can come into contact with the "system" and to highlight its strengths and weaknesses. These highlighted ways, which often aim to limit violence to a limited period of time, can direct the perpetrator to specialized programs or interventions designed specifically to correct and address violent behaviour and to eliminate or reduce the perpetrator's causes once and for all.



Introducing the Norwegian-funded ViolenceOFF project. The project aims to improve the system of treatment of perpetrators and support of victims in cases of domestic and gender-based violence in the Czech Republic. The main objective of the project is to identify good practices and gaps in the current system and to propose effective measures that will improve the situation of victims by reducing the harm caused by violent people.
